הַלְלוּיָהּ is found at the end of the silent meditations (prayers) following the Yigdal

prayer and before the בְּרַכּוּ . The prayer commands us to praise God with the loud sounds of different instruments.

This prayer is Psalm 150, the final Psalm in the book of Psalms. The Book of Psalms shares with its reading all of the many wonderful things about God. Psalm 150 is a final, loud, praise of God. Some form of the word הַלְלוּיָהּ appears 12 times in this Psalm.
