קְדוּשָׁה

Root: ק-ד-ש

Meaning - holy, sacred

Words in the prayer with the root: קְדוּשָׁה שְׁמֵקְדוּשֵׁים

הַקְדוּשָׁה בְּקִדְשׁ קְדוּשָׁתְךָ

The קְדוּשָׁה prayer is the third prayer of the Amidah, the third section of the Shabbat morning service. In most congregations, the congregation says/chants a line and then the leader repeats it. About halfway through the prayer, the leader and the congregation join together in saying/chanting the remainder of the blessing. The first prayer of the Amidah, the אֲבוֹת, reminds us of our connection to our past, while the second prayer, the גְּבוּרוֹת, reminds us of God's power and majesty. The third prayer, the קְדוּשָׁה reminds us that God is holy, and that we are holy because God is holy.

It implies that the best way to imitate God's holiness is by doing mitzvot. It suggests that we should live our lives as if we are always on holy ground when we share with the poor, honor our parents, observe Shabbat, refrain from gossip, and act lovingly toward others. The קְדוּשָׁה teaches us that our actions determine our level of holiness.
