## Family Hanukkiah Contest Rules

- Your Hanukkiah must be handcrafted by YOU (and/or your family)! (And you must have FUN while making it!)
- 2. Only one entry per FAMILY! You'll have to work together! (Any Ages!)
- 3. Your Hanukkiah must be symbolically functional: either be able to be lit with flame, electronically lit up, or have "flames" which can be removed or added.
- 4. The *shamash* (helper candle) must be identifiably different than the other candles.
- 5. Your Hanukkiah must be dropped off in person to Trinity Campus between Friday, December 13 and Friday December 20, NO LATER THAN 5:45pm. *Note: drop off at Hebrew Classes, Fairview or BHY is acceptable prior to Dec. 20.*
- 6. Hanukkiot will be judged "by the people" on creativity, function, and detail! All entrants will receive a Hanukah treat! Best overall winner will earn bragging rights, your family name on our Hanukkah trophy, and the title, <u>"CBB Hanukkiah of the Year"!</u>
- 7. Need not be present to win.
- Hanukkiot will be available for pick up that evening. No guarantees for unclaimed Hanukkiot. No Perishable Hanukkiot prior to December 20.
  Perishable Hanukkot will be eaten or thrown away after judging.
