

Family Hanukkah Contest Rules

1. Your Hanukkah must be handcrafted by YOU (and/or your family)!
(And you must have FUN while making it!)
2. Only one entry per FAMILY! You'll have to work together! (Any Ages!)
3. Your Hanukkah must be symbolically functional: either be able to be lit with flame, electronically lit up, or have "flames" which can be removed or added.
4. The *shamash* (helper candle) must be identifiably different than the other candles.
5. **Your Hanukkah must be dropped off in person to CBB between Friday, December 12 and Sunday, December 14, NO LATER THAN 5:00pm.**
6. Hanukkiot will be judged "by the people" on creativity, function, and detail at our Family Hanukkah Party, Sunday, Dec. 14th, and winners announced at Hanukkah Shabbat, Friday, December 19th.
All entrants will receive a Hanukkah treat!
Best overall winner will earn bragging rights, your family name on our Hanukkah trophy, and the title, **"CBB Hanukkah of the Year"!**
7. Need not be present to win.
8. Hanukkiot will be available for pick up after Dec. 19. No guarantees for unclaimed Hanukkiot. No Perishable Hanukkiot prior to December 14. (Perishable Hanukkot will be eaten or thrown away after judging.)
